- Mississauga is home to 16 Fortune 500 food & beverage (F&B) companies

- Over the next 10 years, 70% of growth in consumer spending will be driven by ethnicity. Mississauga is one of Canada's most diverse cities with over 55% of the population being born abroad.
- Ontario's combined national and provincial corporate tax rates are lower than most

Talented Workforce


- Access to a labour pool of over 5.3 million people within the Greater Toronto Area (GTA), representing nearly half of Ontario's labour force
- Over 77,800 full-time foreign students enrolled in colleges and universities within commuting distance.
- Mississauga is a net importer of talent, drawing in over 230,000 people from surrounding regions for employment
- Local companies benefit from labour costs that are among the lowest of the G-7 countries and apprenticeship training tax credits for some skilled workers
