**Structure:** The GHG Training Program will include four training sessions, as well as one-on-one support.

- Session #1: Purpose of Prioritizing Sustainability in Business (half day, in-person)
- Session #2: Design a Profitable Roadmap to Carbon Neutral (1.5 hour online)
- Session #3: Quantify your Quick Wins and Deep Retrofits (1.5 hour online)
- Session #4: Credible and Affordable Paths for the Last Mile (1.5 hour online)

Participants will be encouraged to advance a specific project over the course of the program. The GHG Training program can be taken in partnership with the GHG Site Assessment program (see program home page for details on GHG Site Assessment program).

Course Fee: \$1,500 per person
