GHG Site Assessments are offered by the City of Mississauga and delivered by Partners in Project Green

Overview: The GHG Site Assessment program will provide each participant with a site assessment walk-through conducted by a team of technical experts to identify energy efficiency and carbon reduction opportunities ranging from low-cost/no-cost measures to high-cost/high-impact measures. The GHG Site Assessment program can be taken in addition, and as a complement to, the GHG Training Program.

Expected Outcomes: Upon completion, each participate will receive a two page summary report outlining energy efficiency and carbon reduction opportunities, as well as supporting incentive programs and funding or financing sources.

Structure: The GHG Site Assessment program will include the following;

- Planning: Introducing participant to technical experts and preparing for site assessment
- Site Walk-Through: Two to five hour site walk-through with technical experts
- Summary Report: Two page report delivered with recommended actions and next steps

Course Date: September, 2023 to June, 2024

Eligible Participants: The GHG Training program is open to any business with a physical, non-residential, occupied building space within Mississauga. Applications will be assessed based on a number of criteria, including business size and capacity to benefit from the program. Businesses within any industry are welcome to apply.
